

2010 NASC National Conference Adviser Responsibilities

Advisers attending the 2010 NASC National Conference will be expected to fulfill their roles and duties as professional educators in charge of their young leaders. As adult leaders, advisers are expected to:

- Review and discuss NASC Participant Commitment responsibilities with student delegates and to clearly define expected and acceptable behavior.
- Be role models for students by following conference rules, curfews and guidelines throughout the conference and encourage students to do the same.
- Respond to health and other needs of the students in your charge. A nurse will be on site at the host school, as well as most off campus activities, and advisers will be contacted should students need medical treatment.
- Attend all conference meetings, activities, and events to supervise your student delegates.
- Sit with your students or respective state delegation and supervise behavior. Students are expected to demonstrate respect toward all students, advisers, presenters, speakers, and guests.
- Supervise your students at all times they are at hotels and ensure that they adhere to designated conference curfew times. Please remind students that there are other hotel guests on property and they need to be considerate of these guests.
- While it is the responsibility of advisers/chaperones to monitor the behavior of their own students, any adviser who witnesses a student behaving inappropriately, including one not from their delegation, has the right to speak to him/her. If the student fails to correct his/her behavior or responds inappropriately, NASC staff should be notified.
