

2010 LEAD Conferences High School Officer Training Program Overview and Information



This in-depth training program is designed for student council and National Honor Society officers or students aspiring to hold officer positions.

The training will be offered at all three 2010 LEAD Conferences: February 5-7, 2010, in Washington, D.C.; February 19-21, 2010, in Chicago, IL; and March 19-21, 2010, in Phoenix, AZ. Students participating in the officer training program will also have the opportunity to attend many of the other workshop sessions and training offered during the LEAD Conference.

Program Purposes

1. Build and enhance personal leadership
2. Provide an understanding of officer duties and responsibilities
3. Provide skills for successful officers
4. Prepare officers to take learned skills back to their own schools & communities

Cost to Attend

There is no additional charge for the training; these sessions are part of the LEAD Conference registration fee and a benefit of membership.

Eligibility

Only students from member schools may participate and must be recommended by their advisers.

Space is Limited

Space is limited therefore only **two students per member school** may attend.

Selection Process

Selection for the training is based on a first-come, first-served basis and current school affiliation (membership) is required. Acceptance will be confirmed via e-mail to the applying school adviser.

Students must complete the official Officer Training Reservation Form to be considered. Forms must be signed by the adviser.
