Adviser Training

Advisers can take advantage of workshop sessions geared towards their unique needs in activity management such as project planning, teambuilding, fundraising, and leadership plus much more.

CEU

By participating in the LEAD Conference, advisers may earn Continuing Education Units (CEUs). NASSP is a member of the International Association for Continuing Education and Training (IACET). LEAD Conferences are approved to provide 1.1 CEU credits for 11 hours of continuous educational training. The CEU certificate will be mailed to qualified applicants following the conference. Check with your school district to see if these credits can be applied toward your educational requirements.

Student Training

Students take part in workshops designed in areas such as creating a positive self image, fundraising ideas, teambuilding and goal setting.

High School Student Officer Training

High school student officers or those students aspiring to become an officer can apply to attend the highly popular officer training program.
